A TIMELINE OF CHANGES

MARCH 2020

**Public Health Emergency (PHE)
declared for COVID-19.**

**Medicaid stops terminations,
regardless of eligibility.**



*** Emergency
extended multiple
times**

*** DCF starts
Medicaid
eligibility review**



DECEMBER 2022

**Congress separates PHE from
Medicaid coverage**

PHE continues.

APRIL 30, 2023

**First Medicaid
terminations begin.**





WORDS TO KNOW

REDETERMINATION

The process by which your eligibility status for Medicaid is determined.*

***Can end in renewal OR termination.**

COVERAGE

Health insurance.

Also means payment for particular services.

RENEWAL

A.K.A.
re-enrollment
re-certification
re-determination*

ELIGIBILITY

Medicaid insurance status

Eligible: can get Medicaid
Ineligible: cannot get Medicaid

Department of Children and Families online service hub.

MARKETPLACE

A.K.A.
ACA, Obamacare
A federal service that offers an online shop for healthcare insurance enrollment and purchase.

AND

- **PREGNANT, OR**
- **PARENT OR GUARDIAN OF A MINOR CHILD, OR**
- **A CHILD**
- **ELDERLY OR DISABLED AND NOT CURRENTLY RECEIVING MEDICARE**
- **FORMERLY IN FOSTER CARE, AND UNDER 26 YEARS OLD**

**MEET THE INCOME GUIDELINES
AND ASSET GUIDELINES IF ELDERLY
OR DISABLED**

YOU'RE LIKELY ELIGIBLE!

FLORIDA'S PLAN

FIRST REVIEW

- Individuals determined to be ineligible in recent review
- Have not used benefits in at least 12 months

SNAP & TANF RECIPIENTS

DCF will attempt to redetermine SNAP/TANF and Medicaid at the same time

LAST REVIEW

- 21 and younger with medically complex conditions
- SSI-related institutional care; hospice care with limited income

Look for the special yellow stripe envelope in your mailbox!

CHECK, CORRECT, COMPLETE

1 Check and correct your contact information on MyACCESS.

1. Log into MyAccess.
2. Click "Report My Changes"
3. Check the boxes you need to edit (Address, Email, Phone Number).
4. Enter your information.
5. Follow prompts to finish and submit.

2 Check your mail, email, phone, AND MyACCESS account for notifications.

Look out for information requests from the Department of Children and Families (DCF)!

3 Complete your benefits renewal in your MyACCESS account.

1. Log into MyAccess.
2. Click "Renew My Benefits" **OR** "Apply for Additional Benefits"
3. Choose the benefits you want to apply for or renew.
4. Enter your information.
5. Follow prompts to finish and submit

DCF needs more information before determining your eligibility. They need documents within 90 days.

Fine Print:

If you get Medicaid for your **child(ren) only**, you do not have to cooperate with Child Support Enforcement (CSE). However, their services to locate an absent parent, establish paternity, or get child support or medical support are available to you free of charge. If you do not cooperate, it will not affect your children's Medicaid.

However, YOUR Medicaid could be affected if you do not cooperate with CSE.



COVERAGE AND CARE OPTIONS

Whether you, your kids, or someone you care about lost coverage, these options can help provide insurance coverage and/or medical care.

Coverage

Federal Health Marketplace

A national service where you can enroll in and purchase health insurance.

Florida KidCare

A program that matches children ages 0-18 with the right Florida KidCare program, for all those eligible.

Care

FQHC

Federally Qualified Healthcare Clinics provide medical care for clients with limited or no health insurance. Click on "FQHC" above to find one in your area.


Local Clinics
