# HOW TO REQUEST SOCIAL SECURITY REIMBURSEMENT FOR MEDICARE PREMIUMS POST-MEDICAID TERMINATION

## LOSING MEDICAID OR MSP COVERAGE?

When a beneficiary eligible for both Medicaid and Medicare loses their Medicaid or Medicare Savings Program (MSP) coverage, the state's obligation to cover Medicare Part B and/or A premiums ends. As a result, the beneficiary becomes responsible for paying the premium costs.

While the individual can withdraw from Part A and/or Part B, the default status is to remain enrolled.

Premium payments may be deducted from Social Security Administration (SSA) benefits, and the first new benefit payment typically reflects a three-month deduction.

### SOLUTIONS

Individuals who are <u>erroneously terminated</u> from Medicaid or an MSP and then reinstated can seek reimbursement from Social Security for withheld benefits due to the loss of premium assistance.

These individuals, as well as those <u>properly terminated and unable to afford immediate payment of past due premiums</u>, have two options that they can pursue **immediately and simultaneously** by contacting the <u>SSA local field office</u> or the <u>SSA 800 number</u> (1-800-772-1213).

# **INSTALLMENT PAYMENTS**

- Must confirm that you cannot afford the lump sum payment.
- Typically, installment plans reimburse most of the past-due premium amount within days.
- Monthly installments can start as low as \$15.
- SSA refunds two months of premiums that were deducted from the benefit payment minus the first installment payment.

# WAIVERS

- Must demonstrate an extreme hardship.
- Complete <u>SSA Form 632</u> and provide required documentation (online or at SSA).
- SSA provides a refund of two-month back premiums with no repayment required.
- Individuals who receive SSI will qualify for a hardship waiver.
