



PRIMARY CARE

In Miami-Dade County, free or reduced-cost primary, as well as prenatal care, is provided to eligible county residents through the Jackson Health System (JHS).

[This link](#) provides information on how to apply for free or reduced-cost care at JHS. If you are a county resident and your application for a Jackson Prime Card has been denied or delayed, you can contact Florida Health Project (FHJP).

In addition to primary and prenatal care through JHS, uninsured county residents can seek care through free clinics or federally qualified health centers (FQHCs). For FQHCs, services are based on a sliding scale. Contact information for FQHCs and other clinics is listed below:

FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE AT NON-PROFIT HOSPITALS

Under the Affordable Care Act (ACA), the following Miami-Dade County public and non-profit hospitals have financial assistance plans (FAP) and must follow rules before certain collection actions can be taken against you for an unpaid hospital bill. Mount Sinai Medical Center

Mount Sinai provides financial assistance to eligible persons who have healthcare needs and are uninsured, ineligible for a government program, or are otherwise unable to pay, for medically necessary care or emergency medical conditions based on their individual financial situation. Baptist Hospital

Baptist Hospital provides free care to people who have no health insurance and who qualify for their financial assistance program. Uninsured patients may qualify for discounts depending on family income. Information on the financial assistance program can be found [here](#).
