ORDER TO SHOW CAUSE

THIS CAUSE came before the Court on the Petitioners' "Complaint for Writ of Mandamus," filed on March 9, 2026. The Court having considered the same, it is hereby:

ORDERED AND ADJUDGED that Respondents shall, within 30 calendar days of the date of service of this order, show cause why the relief requested in the Petition should not be granted. A copy of the Petition with attachments shall be enclosed with the service of this order. The Response shall be filed with this Court per the divisional instructions (with a copy of the proposed order) and must address all of the allegations made in the Petition and include copies of all documents necessary to establish the validity of the actions challenged by Petitioners. Requests for extension of time to file a Response or Reply will not be granted unless good cause is demonstrated to the satisfaction of the Court.

If Petitioners choose to file a Reply to the Respondent's Response, the Reply must be filed with the Clerk of Court within 15 calendar days from the date of the certificate of service on the Respondent's Response. Petitioners shall cause a copy of the Reply to be served on the Respondent. The Petitioner may also submit a proposed order for the court's consideration if he/she wishes to do so. Requests for extensions of time to file a Response or Reply will not be granted unless good cause is demonstrated to the satisfaction of the Court.

Petitioner shall serve a copy of this order as required by law for service on the State.
